1) From the Desk of Jack Smith...

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON April 19, 2011

1. Goose and Coot Management Update

Shoreline Staff has been monitoring Shoreline for geese nests and adding the eggs. Thus far in the Santa Clara County area about 120 eggs have been added. ... The Coots continue to leave for their trip north.

2. Status of the Golf Course Report

Jack gave an update of the process to the Committee. Jack mentioned that the non binding RFP's have been sent out and are due May 3rd. 16 potential vendors came to the information meeting, Shoreline answered about 88 of their questions, and they now have about 50 additional questions to deal with. The goal is to bring the options to the Mountain View City Council in the June/July time frame. ... It looks like the proposals will be to act as a management company and not as an agent leasing the facility. ... Michaels has signed a new 5 year lease and will be purchasing a new beverage cart for better service.

3. Superintendent's Update

Steve reported that all greens are aerated and that plugging will begin to fill in the "troubled" spots. ... Practice greens were delayed, due to Demo Day, but that is now also complete. ... Fairway aeration will begin next week.

4. GolfNow.com

Jack mentioned that staff is working with GolfNow.com which is owned by The Golf Channel and markets their service on television and on the Internet. There have been some contract and software problems but staff feels that will all be worked out by May 15. ... Staff will let the Committee know as soon as Shoreline is listed on GolfNow.com.

5. Advisory Greens Committee

Jack let the Committee know that there are now 4 applicants and that he would be meeting with the Community Services Director to review the next steps.

6. Bathroom cleaning. Bathroom cleaning service is Monday, Wednesday and Fridays. They will ask the student volunteer to help out and request that the Marshals check the bathrooms on their rounds to pick up excess paper, etc.
