### **1) SHORELINE GOLF LINKS ADVISORY GREENS COMMITTEE:**

The greens committee meeting was cancelled for July. Here is a summary of the current activity:

a) The city council has given us approval to interview for, the staff appointed advisory greens committee, two "at large" vacant positions. We had one interview already and one scheduled in the later part of July for final appointments. Following the full committee appointments, we will then schedule a meeting in early August.

b) Regarding the management of the Golf Course:

We have narrowed the selection to three finalists and are currently working on background checks, references, site tours, and evaluating each company's financial viability. We will be returning to the City Council in September with the status of the background on the finalists and a revised City-operating model. We are currently scheduled for September 13<sup>th</sup>.

c) Ponds project:

Bids are scheduled to be received this month for the work on filling in the three ponds. It will take about a month to finalize a contract with the top low bidder. Work should start in late August.

d) Course maintenance:

It is ongoing with lower mow heights on the greens and use of the Goose Poop removal machine on the fairways, when it is working. Some bunkers will get more sand from the Sand Reserve, but there is not enough sand to do many.
