1) SHORELINE GOLF LINKS ADVISORY GREENS COMMITTEE:

- a) The Mountain View City Council has selected Touchtone Golf Management Company to become the new management firm for the Shoreline Golf Course. They currently manage five other courses which include two in southern California and three in the bay area (Roddy Ranch in Antioch, Mare Island in Vallejo and Lake Chabot in Oakland). The council is still negotiating the final contract with them and it is estimated that they will take over in January 2012.

- b) Update on Pond Project:

Rey Rodriguez, Project Engineer, reviewed the plans and schedule of converting Ponds 1 (by 17th green), 2 (by 11th & 12th holes) and 3 (10th tee) by filling them in with dirt and creating a landscaped feature that will hopefully minimize the goose and coot population, while additionally providing a burrowing owl mitigation area.

Pond 1 has begun the pumping of the remaining water and dirt has been delivered and is nearing completion.

Pond 2 has been cleared for the project pumping to begin in September. Dirt delivery should begin in early October.

Pond 3 is cleared to begin in the middle of September. A dirt haul road will need to be constructed from the maintenance road across the 18th fairway and across the back of the driving range. This will begin in early October.

- c) GolfNow.com – status:

Shoreline Golf Links is now up and operating for tee time reservations. The first week had about 25 new golfers. Discounted rates are available online for slow activity times.

- d) Parking lot was resurfaced and restriped. It is now a whole lot easier to see the actual parking spaces.

- e) Cart paths that needed the most repairs were repaved. This included the cart paths on holes 1, 15, 16 and 18.

3) Shoreline Red Tee Handicap:

We have some members that are playing from the red tees during normal tournaments while other members are playing from the white tees. In order for everyone playing from the red tees to accurately use the correct handicap you must take the course rating into consideration. Here's the USGA guide on how to account for golfers playing from different tees:

“Different tees usually have different ratings. Because a USGA Course Rating reflects the probable score of a scratch golfer, the higher rated course is more difficult, and the player playing from the set of tees with the higher USGA Course Rating receives additional stroke(s) equal to the difference between each USGA course rating, with .5 or greater rounded upward. The additional stroke(s) are added to the player playing from the higher rated set of tees. ”

EXAMPLE:

If men playing from middle tees where the men's USGA course rating is 70.3 compete against men playing from the back tees where the men's USGA Course Rating is 72.6, the men playing from the back tees will add 2 strokes ($72.6 - 70.3$ equals 2.3 rounded to 2) to their course handicap."

In our case playing from the red instead of the white 69.3 minus red of 66.5 equals 2.8 rounded to 3. So the player from the red tees will subtract 3 strokes from their handicap. So if the sheet at the sign-in table shows that your handicap is 20, and you are playing in the format described here, then your handicap for the tournament will be 17.

4) Hole-In-One:

On Monday, August 29th, Dave Biklen made a hole-in-one on the par 3 fourth hole. Dave hit a 6 iron and was playing a Callaway ball.
