Treasurer's Report (Jeff):

- Balance as of Sept. 2026: \$1548

Membership (Bryan):

- Membership roster is currently at 67
 - Only 1 new member joined from Member/Guest tournament
- Bryan will send out 2027 club renewal information in October 2027 club dues will remain unchanged at \$100

NCGA (Rick)

- 2027 NCGA fees will remain unchanged at \$48
- Any new members should only be added after January 1, 2027

Greens Committee Update (Gary)

- Next AGC meeting schedule for Wednesday, Sept. 24, 2026
- Bridge Project
 - Work started on #1 bridge but was halted after drilling brought up garbage/debris. New plan being developed but will need to be approved by CA Dept. of Fish and Wildlife.
 - Gary will provide updates as more information becomes available

2027 Schedule (Bill)

- Bill will send draft of 2027 schedule out within the next few weeks
- Changes agreed upon:
 - Revise Modified Stableford Points to the following: Birdie = 3 pts (increased from 2 pts)
 - Add 2-man scramble format with teams being randomly paired
 - Add 2-man alternate shot format

Other Business

- Dennis asked for suggestions/innovative ideas to help improve the club vs. keeping the status quo. Various ideas/suggestions discussed included:
 - Rotating players and groups – how can we foster more member interaction?
Can/should we modify the weekly sign-up sheet process and eliminate pre-populated names?
 - Pace of play - pros and cons of having members continue to record start and end times
 - Use of app-based technology to make scorekeeping easier (e.g. blue golf)
 - Sponsor fundraising or charity event

 - Quarterly newsletter - Rick volunteered to publish a quarterly newsletter to include topics/information submitted by the board/members
 - Starting 2027, separate closest-to-the-pin pots for Red Tees and White Tees
